

Hall of Honor Nomination Form Information Page

Nominations for Hall of Honor Inductions are due by the previous July.

Nominations may be submitted at any time. However, any nomination for the current selection period must be received by July of the prior year (submit in July of 2026 for induction in 2027). Any nomination received after that date will be considered for subsequent periods.

Nominees may be eligible in one of the following three categories:

- **Cadet Corps Alumni**—Any individual is eligible who has participated one or more years in the Army ROTC program at the University of Texas at Arlington or any of the former schools of what is now the University of Texas at Arlington. Individuals may be nominated for their outstanding accomplishments in a military or civilian career.
- **Honorary**—Any individual is eligible who, although not a participant in the Cadet Corps, served as a member of the staff of the Military Science Department, staff and faculty of the University of Texas at Arlington, or any of the former schools that are part of the University's lineage, or special friends of the Cadet Corps. Any individual nominated in this category must have demonstrated through his/her service a special dedication or significant contribution to the Cadet Corps. Nominations in this category are limited and controlled by the Cadet Corps Alumni Council.
- **Service**—This category is reserved to recognize those individuals who did not participate in the Cadet Corps and do not meet the criteria for the Honorary category, but who attended and received a degree, undergraduate or graduate, from the University of Texas at Arlington, or any of the former schools of what is now the University of Texas at Arlington. Such individuals must have served in a branch of the U.S. armed forces and achieved a noteworthy accomplishment in his/her military and/or civilian career. Nominations in this category will only be considered in very exceptional cases and will be controlled and limited by the Corps of Cadets Alumni Council.”

Nominations provided in previous years will also be considered for this year's recognition.

Degrees Received from other Colleges or Universities:. Include University, Degree, and Graduation Year for each

Commissioning: If nominee was commissioned at UTA when, branch, circumstances surrounding commissioning. Was nominee a Distinguished Military Graduate?

Military Career: Provide a complete description of individual's military career to include major accomplishments, awards and decorations. If individual did not have a military career explain the reason. Provide reasons for major military awards.

Professional Achievement: Describe the candidate's current/most recent job responsibilities. Show how the nominee attained prominence through his or her efforts in his or her industry or profession. Include key memberships, directorships, awards, citations, medals, commendations, honoraria's, etc. Candidates should have attained prominence in their industry or profession. Their work should have a demonstrated impact. Describe the impact.

Community Service, Outstanding Service to Industry or Profession: Explain how the candidate demonstrates a commitment to service within their community. Include participation in civic, service or religious organizations.

Loyalty and Support to UTA and Military Science Department: Please explain how the candidate's deeds and actions demonstrate pride in their alma mater and an interest in and support of UTA or the ROTC program if graduating from a participating university.

Reason for nomination: Explain why you think nominee should become a member of the Hall of Honor.
